- who is an undergraduate student who is in her last two years of college and has the intent to continue academically and professionally in the field of education OR
- who is a graduate student who has graduate standing in an institution offering an education degree and has the intent to continue academically and professionally in the field of education.

The Honor of Being Invited:

Selection is based on professional qualifications, leadership potential and personal qualities. Those who accept the invitation to join commit to being active participants in the life of the organization and pay nominal annual membership dues.

Dues: \$83 yearly, \$10 induction fee.
